d. The system is changed so that (when it is in operation) the water of the cooling tower system does not recirculate in the system; or
e. The system is changed so that it is no longer a cooling tower system, within the meaning of Part7 of the <i>Public Health & Wellbeing Act 2008</i> .
And a sign has been placed on the cooling tower system indicating that the cooling tower system must not be re-activated without first contacting the Department of Health.

a. An electrical switch for the cooling tower is turned off;
b. The water supply tap to the cooling tower system is closed; and/or
c. The water is drained from the cooling tower system.
